In the late 1950s, it was the vision of the late Canon Guok Koh Moh to plant a church in the Holland Road vicinity. This was realized on Sunday 11 March 1973, when the foundation stone was laid by the Archbishop of Canterbury, The Most Revd Michael Ramsey. Since then, the building had undergone a few extension projects as the work of the parish grew. Past Vicars, pastors and members have all contributed to this parish.

We have now come to a stage where these facilities need to be rebuilt to facilitate the needs of future generations.
